Since our last letter in August, God has been busy in both our personal lives and the life of the church.



On the personal front, we are proud to announce that Zachary Marshall Moye (8 pounds 5 ounces, 21 ½ inches) was born on August 13. Zachary now weighs over 14 pounds, and he is a vibrant, happy little boy. We thank the Lord for this new addition to our family, and we ask that you keep him in prayer. One week after he was born, Zachary was diagnosed with Congenital Adrenal Hyperplasia (CAH), the same problem that affects our first son, Ethan. Two hospital stays, numerous doctors visits, and multiple blood tests later; we are thankful that on October 19 his latest tests showed that all the chemicals in his body are finally at acceptable levels. God is good, and we are confident He will continue to bless Zachary in the days and weeks to come.



On the church front, we are excited to report that Independent Baptist Church of Georgetown (IBCG) hosted its first Missions Emphasis Day on Sunday, September 5. Dr. Pat Creed, BIMC Caribbean Director, was our guest speaker, and we were blessed to have three missionary families share their testimonies. Following three challenging messages from Dr. Creed (and a fine meal prepared by our ladies), the members of IBCG, via the grace of God, made Faith Promise pledges totaling \$663.00 per month or \$7,956.00 per year. As a result, IBCG voted to begin supporting four missionary families in addition to the two already supported by the church.

IBCG is continuing to evangelize our own Jerusalem through tract distribution, door knocking, and the personal outreach of our members. Since our last letter, we have had one baptism, and we have been visited by 12 local guests, as well as several guests from out of town. On November 14, we will be hosting a combined First Year Anniversary/Thanksgiving service. Please pray that many people from the local area will attend the services.
